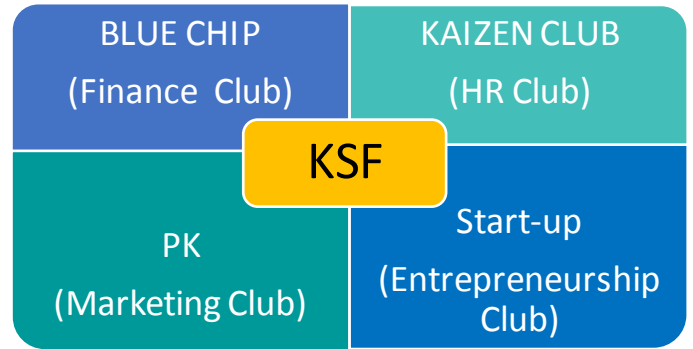
CLUB ACTIVITIES

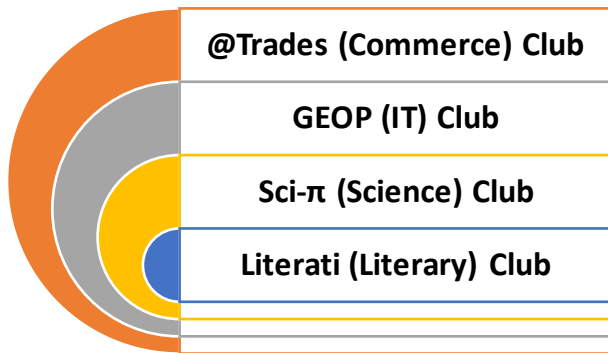
CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

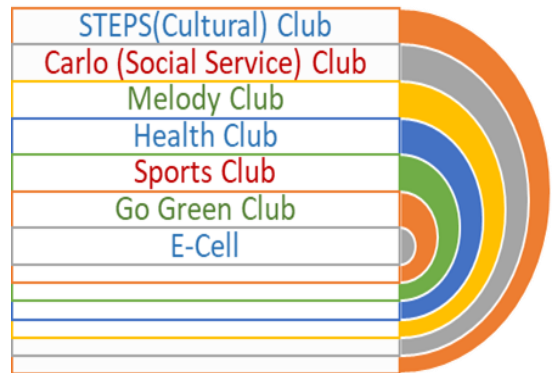
SPARK (SHARING PRESENT AND RECENT KNOWLEDGE) FORUM (U.G.)
